Summary

This presentation aims to summarize the **key findings of a global survey conducted by UNESCO** during Dec. 2020 and Feb. 2021 on the impacts of COVID-19 pandemic on higher education around the world and how the countries have responded to it in terms of **access to education, equity and quality of teaching and learning, university operations, national challenges, emerging issues, and strategic changes.**

Based on these survey findings, the author provides **major implications for Vietnam higher education** which can be utilized in strategic planning and actions (at state and institutional levels) in order to adapt to the impacts caused by COVID-19 and long-term development.
